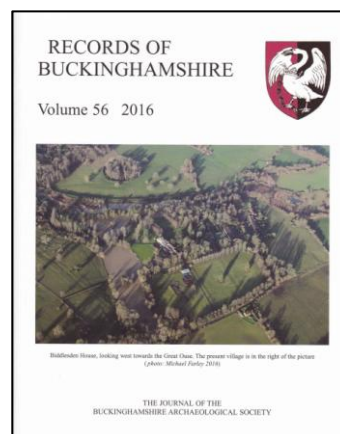


Records of Buckinghamshire 2016 – volume 56
