

MEMORIAL WINDOW TO THE LATE MR. AND MRS. FIELD.

ST MARY'S CHURCH, AYLESBURY.—A small lancet window in the south aisle of this Church having been lately- restored by the Venerable Archdeacon Bickersteth, it has been filled with stained glass at the cost of Mr. Field, of this town. The glass is the work of Mr. Oliphant, who also executed the north and south windows in the chancel. The subject is the Apostle St. Peter. Both the figure and the setting are well treated, and the colouring is neat and chaste. On the splay of the window is a monumental brass bearing the following inscription:—" To the glory " of God, and to the dear memory of Thomas White Field " and Ann his wife. He died March 11. MDCCCXXXII. aged " LIX. She died June xxiir. MDCCCXXXII. aged LVII.— " Erected by their affectionate Son A.D. MDCCCLVIII."
